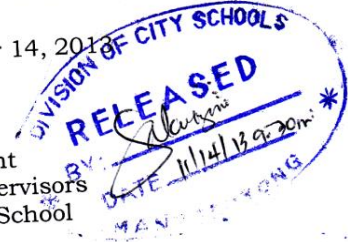




**BONIFACIO PARA SA KABATAAN PROJECT**  
**Multi-Arts Learning Activities About Bonifacio and the Katipunan**

1. In celebration of the 150<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of *Andres Bonifacio*, founder of the *Katipunan* and leader of the struggle for Philippine Independence from Spain, the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) and the Department of Education (DepEd), will conduct a series of **Multi-Arts Learning Activities About Bonifacio and the Katipunan** from June to November 2013 at various sites nationwide (see enclosed Program of Activities).
2. The Multi-Arts Learning Activities aim to:
  - a. enable Grades 4-6 pupils to relate to *Bonifacio* and the ideals of the *Katipunan* in a meaningful way using original songs, animation, dance and various arts and other interactive learning experiences; and
  - b. encourage teachers to employ innovative pedagogical methods which apply art in the teaching of *Araling Panlipunan/Heograpiya, Kasaysayan at Sibika (HEKASI)*.
3. The participants to these activities are the elementary pupils and teachers from selected cities in the country.
4. The program of activities will be done in two parts. The first part is the training for teacher-facilitators which will start from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon. The second part is the conduct of the main activity which will be held in the afternoon at 1:00-4:00 p.m. All activities will be held at the SM Activity Centers inside SM Malls located in the target cities. The schedule and scheme for the abovementioned activities are contained in the enclosure.
5. In line with this, identified regions are enjoined to select the pupils and teachers who will participate in their cluster sites. Likewise, each region will designate one focal person who will coordinate with NHCP in regards to the activities.
6. The NHCP will fund all expenses for the training of teacher facilitators and the Multi-Arts Activities except the transportation expenses of the participants. Travel expenses of the central, regional and division office personnel and participating teachers and pupils shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

II. Selection of Participants

- There will be 25 teachers and 500 grades 4-6 pupils per cluster site who will participate in the Multi-arts learning activities about Bonifacio and the Katipunan except in Metro Manila where there will be 50 teachers and 750 pupils participating.
- Regions, through the concerned Schools Division Superintendents, shall select the teachers and grade 4-6 pupils from the identified city divisions. However, regions may also select teachers and participants from nearby divisions.
- The apportioning of slots shall be equally distributed among the three grade levels.
- Selected teachers who shall participate in the facilitators' training should be from among those teachers who have participating grades 4-6 pupils.
- Considering the nature of the activities, the schools should make necessary provisions for make-up classes for affected teachers and pupils.

III. Program Scheme

A. Training of Teacher-Facilitators

This activity will familiarize teacher-facilitators with the music, activities and exercises to be applied in the actual Multi-Arts Activities. This will last for two to three hours which will include orientation and instructions on how to facilitate the activities for children.
