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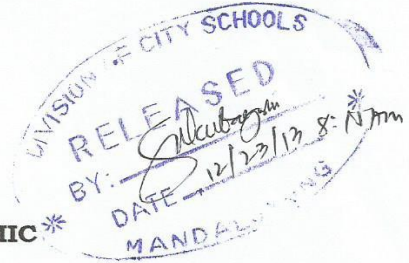

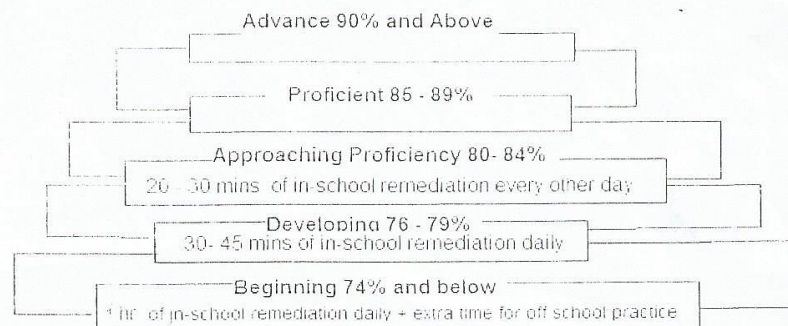

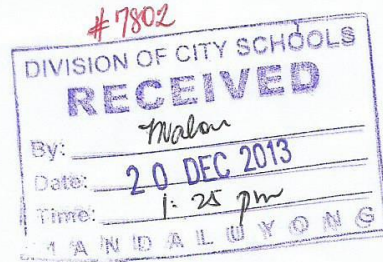
To: Schools Division Superintendents

- To develop thinking and reasoning skills, ask students to provide written explanations why two of the wrong answers are incorrect. Provide meaningful exercises on the least mastered skills.
- For proficient and advanced students offer more choices for independent or collaborative work including choice of projects, topics, test items and homework/ assignments.
- A tiered model for bridging gaps (DepEd Order No. 39 s. 2012) is provided as follows:
