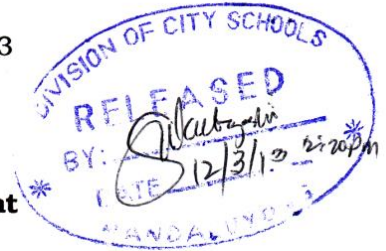

PROVIDING ALS LEARNING SERVICES AND INTERVENTIONS TO SCHOOL DROPOUTS FOR SY 2013 – 2014 AND OTHER MARGINALIZED GROUPS

TO : *Schools Division Superintendents
ALS Division Supervisors / Coordinators
Lead DALSCs and PASAMO Officers*

- In preparation for CY 2014, implementation of all ALS programs / projects and in reiteration to DepEd NCR Memo no, 122, s. 2013, dated June 14, 2013, entitled "Implementation of Alternative Learning System's Programs / Projects in Every Public Elementary and Secondary School Starting SY 2013-2014", all Schools Divisions shall now undertake massive advocacy activities from November – December, 2013 such as recruitment of school dropouts / OSYs and adults.
- As discussed during the 8th Regional MANCOM Meeting held in the Division of Malabon City on November 15, 2013, all Schools Divisions are directed to coordinate with all public Elementary and Secondary Schools in their respective jurisdiction to encourage school principals to refer / track down and report all their dropouts and avail of the ALS learning interventions as a solution to the escalating number of school leavers.
- The ALS Division Personnel are requested to provide all needed assistance to all schools who are and will be implementing the Alternative Learning System.
- All Schools Divisions are advised to submit to the Region all ALS activities currently undertaken by their ALS Personnel in preparation for the CY 2014 – 2015 implementation of ALS programs / projects on or before November 29, 2013. ALS Enrolment data in Basic Literacy Program, Accreditation & Equivalency program, BPOSA, and other ALS programs / projects shall be forwarded to the Regional Office on or before December 20, 2013 using the ALS MIS Forms.
- Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

**IMPLEMENTATION OF ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM'S [ALS] PROGRAMS / PROJECTS
IN EVERY PUBLIC ELEMENTARY and SECONDARY SCHOOL STARTING SY 2013 - 2014**


TO : *Schools Division Superintendents
ALS Division Supervisors / Coordinators
School Heads, Public Elementary / Secondary Schools*

1. In order to realize the eight [8] Millennium Development Goals [MDG] particularly on **Achieving Universal Primary Education** and attain our EFA targets for 2015, which is the **Universal Coverage of Out-of-School Youths and Adults in the provision of basic learning needs**, every public elementary and secondary school shall implement the Alternative Learning System's [ALS] programs / projects effective SY 2013 - 2014 as a strategy to address congestion and alarming dropout problem.
2. The drop-out rate, S.Y. 2011 – 2012 of .76% in the Public Elementary Schools, this Region and a still higher rate of 6.15% in the Secondary Level has to be addressed. This move will also enable each school to provide a catch up program for their own school leavers as well as the OSYs and adults in the community.
3. Every school shall submit to their respective schools divisions the data on their school leavers as well as pupils / students-at-risk of dropping out [PARDOs / SARDOs] who will become the potential learners of the ALS program.
4. The ALS Division Supervisors / Coordinators and the School Heads are tasked to coordinate with the LGU, Barangay Officials, PTCA and other stakeholders relative to the successful implementation of the program.
5. The Regional core of Trainers of ALS Division will provide technical assistance / capability building program and orientation program for new school heads and additional IMs upon invitation of the Division. In addition, schools with computer laboratories accessible to both formal and ALS learners can request the Region installation of ALS eSkwela / eLearning digitized modules and educational video materials from the Knowledge Channel Foundation, Incorporated.
6. Soft copies of the ALS learning materials / modules both the print and digitized modules are available at the schools divisions through the division ALS supervisors / coordinators
7. The ALS learning sessions may be conducted either on weekdays or on Saturdays depending upon the availability of the designated schools Instructional Managers, learners and facilities.

8. A report on the initial implementation of this program following the Division ALS template report shall be observed and submitted to the ALS Division using the attached format on or before August 16, 2013.

9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
