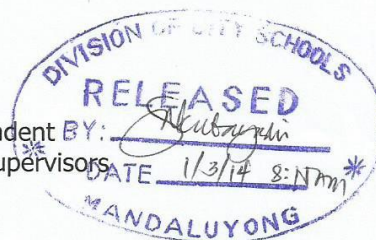

OFF-CAMPUS INTERACTION

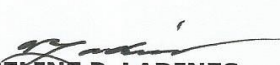
The Lourdes School of Mandaluyong is engaging the **Grade VI Pupils** to an **Off-Campus Interaction from other schools**.

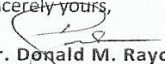
It is for this reason that we are humbly asking for your permission to allow our Grade VI Pupils to revisit and interact with the students in the schools enumerated below:

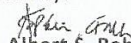
