

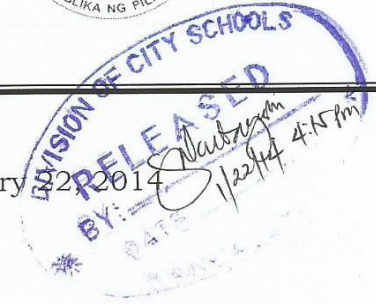

Dear Dr. Ladines:

For the past two years, it is observed that the Liberation Day Parade has become so long that the sun has already set yet the parade has not ended. Normally this event is expected to last for two hours only, from 2:00pm-4:00pm.

The Organizing Committee is certainly happy that more and more people are interested to join the annual parade. However, this causes great problems like lack of space for assembly, heavy traffic, uncontrollable crowd and participants to some extent; foremost, it gets dark early these days, thus, the participants at the tail end of the parade are complaining.

For a try this year, since Mandaluyong Day falls on a Sunday, the committee is limiting the participation of the school sector to the following:

- ✓ A. Two groups of Lavandero Festival Dancers to highlight the segment theme: "MANDALENO...Nagpapahalaga sa Kultura at Edukasyon".  
The dancers are 80 IBIS and 80 ILIS pupils.
- ✓ B. 100 Male High School students from CMSHS and MHS who will serve as FLAGBEARERS.
- ✓ C. 50 Female High School students from CMSHS who will serve as Parade Usherettes.
- ✓ D. Token delegations of the following schools as in the previous years will line up along routes of the parade. MHS, MES, ERIS, DPES, FPJES and PES.


The delegations of both the public and private schools which constitute the marching and walking units are temporarily shelved off this year.
