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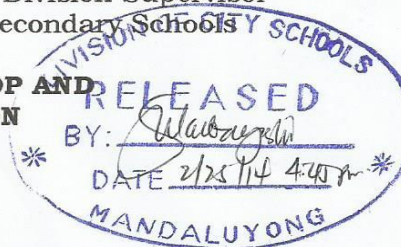

**FIFTH MTAP NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP AND CONFERENCE
ON MATHEMATICS EDUCATION**

The Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) will conduct its *Fifth MTAP National Seminar-Workshop and Conference on Mathematics Education* with the theme *Mathematics: Meeting the Challenges of the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum* on April 23-26, 2014 at the Bohol Cultural Center of the Philippines, Bohol City, and from April 28 to May 1, 2014 at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

The Conference aims to:

- a. update the participants on the latest Mathematics Curriculum towards the K to 12 Program;
- b. enhance the knowledge and skills of elementary and secondary school heads and Mathematics teachers to produce graduates who are independent and life-long learners;
- c. strengthen the commitment of Mathematics teachers to their vocation as molders of the youth;
- d. acquaint Mathematics teacher-educators from Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) of the demands of Mathematics teachers in the field to align the preparation of pre-service elementary and secondary teachers to equip them with the knowledge and skills expected to them;
- e. provide them with a venue for the sharing of experiences in integrating ICT in the teaching of Mathematics; and
- f. develop a network of Mathematics teachers, school heads and teachers educators who will work together towards excellence in Mathematics education.

The participants of the conference are principals, department Mathematics heads/coordinators, Mathematics teachers, regional and division/district supervisors involved in Mathematics from both public and private elementary and secondary schools and teachers in TEIs.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*. This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, *An Act Prohibiting the Sale of tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and University* (Ganzon Law).
