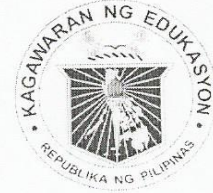

"ACTS": Advocating Change Through Schools

The ACTS Movement is anchored on the Adopt-a-School Program of CFC Educational Foundation, Inc. (CFCEFI). This movement aims to institutionalize values and character formation seminars in schools, both public and private. The programs implemented through this movement has been going on since 2003 (as per report attached), and we remain dedicated to further the reach of this service as CFCEFI's commitment to the Adopt-A-School Program of the Department of Education.

For School Year 2014 and beyond, we are proposing the following programs for the public schools.

Phase 1

LIFE IN CHRIST SEMINAR

Audience: Parents; Teaching/Non-Teaching Staff

Length of Activity: Two Full Days

Program Description:

We have initiated "Live Christ, Share Christ" (LCSC), a movement whose vision is to mainstream grassroots Catholic evangelization, aimed to bring about moral recovery and values transformation in our institutions, parishes, schools, private and government entities through a program called "Life in Christ Seminar." This is actually meant to help effect sustained and more lasting transformation in our society by renewing, refreshing and reinvigorating our Christian spirituality through a series of talks that will enable the participants to meet Christ, live Christ and share Christ in their daily lives.

The LCS has been initially conducted for the faculty of Kamuning Elementary School (May 28 and 30, 2013), Libis Elementary School (July 24-26, 2013), P. Bernardo Elementary School (Aug. 2, 16, 30, Sept. 5 and 6, 2013), and to all Guidance Counselors of all QC public elementary and high schools on September 26-27, 2013.

Note: We are also proposing to conduct the LCS to your office staff, as well as all QC District Superintendents and School Heads.

LIVE PURE ASSEMBLIES

Audience: Students (elementary level; high school level)

Length of Activity: Once a month; 2-3 hours per session

Program Description:

These assemblies are composed of lectures with dynamic activities. Topics include issues on chastity, love, and relationships in general. For the elementary graders, the value for chastity is presented through values talks and activities carefully adapted to the cognitive and emotional development of the children.

Phase 2

REGULAR MONTHLY/BI-MONTHLY ASSEMBLIES

Audience: Parents, Teaching/Non-teaching Staff, Students

Length of Activity: Once a month; 1-2 hours per session; separate sessions are conducted for the parents, teaching/non-teaching staff, students (the session schedules are agreed upon by our institution and the adopted school)

Program Description:

A variety of topics are offered to the teaching/non-teaching staff, parents, and students of an adopted school. We provide a menu of all topics/modules which the school head can choose from. The school head may also request for other topics based on the needs of her institution.

"Note: Our training materials have been approved by the Department of Education. This eventually led to an Adopt-A-School Memorandum of Agreement between our foundation and DepEd (documents herewith attached for your guidance).

Phase 3

MARRIAGE ENRICHMENT RETREAT

Audience: Parents and Teachers

Length of Activity: Two Full Days

Program Description:

We strongly believe that the family is the seedbed of society. A healthy family breeds a healthy nation. The core of the family is the relationship between husband and wife. Thus, this two-day retreat aims to enhance husband-wife intimacy.

This retreat is ideal for the parents of the graduating class of a given school year, thus serving as our legacy to the students and their families. This is also open to the whole teaching/non-teaching staff, PTAs, and parents from the other grade/year levels.

CELL GROUPINGS/REGULAR MONTHLY GATHERING

Audience: Teaching/Non-teaching staff

Length of Activity: Once a month; 1-2 hours per session

Program Description:

A wide array of topics specifically developed to enrich the spiritual development of the school are taken up for every session. The teaching/non-teaching staff are grouped into cells led by facilitators (agreed upon by both CFCEFI and the school head). These facilitators (cell group head) shall be initially equipped by our team through a series of seminars focusing on servant-leadership.


After Phase 3, we are still committed to conduct regular/continuing parent seminars, teacher formation, and values assemblies for students for all adopted schools.

The Couples for Christ Educational Foundation, Inc. is a non-stock, non-profit organization which is the implementing arm of Couples for Christ Foundation for Family and Life in the area of education. CFC - EFI implements education programs for children and adults, through its pre-school program, adult education program through the Alternative Learning System Accreditation & Equivalency (in partnership with the Department of Education), day care program (in partnership with the Department of Social Welfare and Development), special education program, reading program, and the setting up of community learning centers through our "Bahay Karunungan Reading and Literacy Centers". It also provides learning opportunities to indigenous peoples and Muslims.

Another on-going partnership we have with the Department of Education is the Adopt-A-Public School Program, by virtue of the Memorandum of Agreement forged between our organization and the DepEd in 2013. The program, initially implemented in Bagumbayan Elementary School in Libis, Quezon City, has grown to accommodate the Guidance Department of DepEd-QC and other public schools. We are very blessed to be working closely with QC District Supervisor, Miss Mercuria Ganaden. She has been very instrumental in bringing our program to several public schools.

Our Empowerment and Mentoring Program for Parents, Caregivers, and Teachers (IMPACT) provide the backdrop of our formation and training sessions for the said stakeholders. Recently, we started conducting formation sessions for the students as well. We see the teachers, parents, and students as catalysts of positive change in the community and the country as a whole, as we enrich their values and virtues. It was so unfortunate that the principal of Malaya Elementary School, Ms. Aireen Dulfo, and the PTA and faculty opted not to continue with the values formation sessions for the teachers, parents and children. Among the reasons they cited were the school's difficulty to provide equipment (LCD, laptop, etc.) to make each session interesting. What they failed to acknowledge was that as soon as we saw that they had no resources, it was our foundation and our resource speakers who ALWAYS brought these equipment every session. The school and their PTA even drafted a resolution to "abolish" the formation program for parents, teachers, and students.

We just hope that more public schools will be open to formation sessions and programs. All these will redound to the benefit of the students and the community as a whole. What will happen to the Philippine education system if we have school heads and teachers like Mrs. Dulfo and her staff who are not open to such partnerships/programs?

 1. Mrs. Thelma T. Co – we began working with her in 2006 when she was still the Principal of Bagumbayan Elementary School (BES). The programs in BES continued until 2009. 


