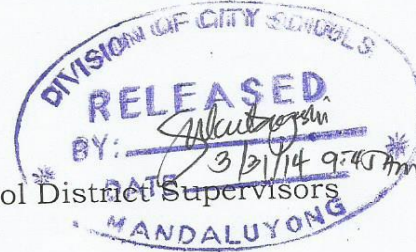

The Office of the Ombudsman is starting a review of the Graft and Corruption Prevention Education (GPCE) Teaching Exemplars for both the elementary and secondary levels. In this regard, Ombudsman representatives Lourdes L. Estonanto, Angelita DL. Cusi, Eva R. Collado, and Cristina Cabrera will be visiting different schools in that Division, to coordinate with Principals and Teachers. The aim of the school visits is to collect Teachers' feedback, suggestions, and ideas on how the content and methodology of the Exemplars may be enhanced and made relevant to present needs of the learners.

It may be recalled that the Exemplars were distributed to public schools in 2007 pursuant to DepEd Memorandum Circular No. 237, s. 2007. Since then, several demonstration classes were conducted by selected Teachers in both levels, showcasing the use of the Exemplars. Some Teachers even introduced changes in the Exemplars' teaching methodology and additional learning activities with good results.

It is noted that the DepEd has started making necessary adjustments in the basic education curriculum to implement the K-12 Basic Education Program. Hopefully, the informal exchanges between our staff and the Teachers will also inspire the creation of Teaching Exemplars for Grades 11 and 12.


Kindly disseminate this communication to School Principals. We are counting on your support and cooperation pursuant to the provision of Section 33 of the Ombudsman Act (R.A. No. 6770) which states:

Section 33. Duty to Render Assistance to the Office of the Ombudsman.—Any officer or employee of any department, bureau or office, subdivision, agency or instrumentality of the Government, including government-owned or controlled corporations and local governments, when required by the Ombudsman, his Deputy or Special Prosecutor shall render assistance to the Office of the Ombudsman.
