

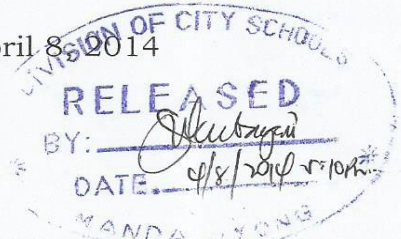

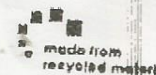

**GUIDELINES FOR SCREENING AND SELECTION OF GRANTEES
(Aboitiz Foundation High School Assistance)**

For a student to be eligible for the Financial Assistance Program, he or she must:

- 1) Be a class valedictorian graduate of any public elementary school in Metro Manila
- 2) Have a general average of at least ninety percent (90%) upon completion to elementary education
- 3) Be willing to enrol in any public school for his or her secondary education, and
- 4) Must pass the qualifying examination
