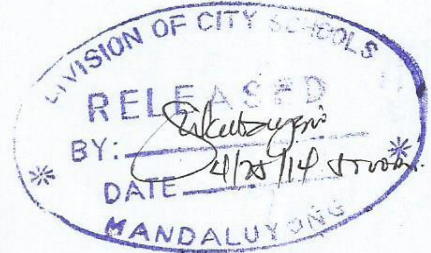

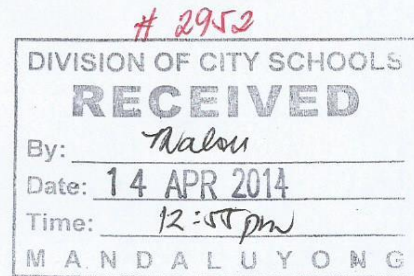


Once again, the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS) will be conducting its regular activity for teachers – the annual seminar-training entitled “School Teachers’ Seminar-Training on Natural Hazards Awareness and Preparedness Focus on Earthquakes and Volcanoes”.
