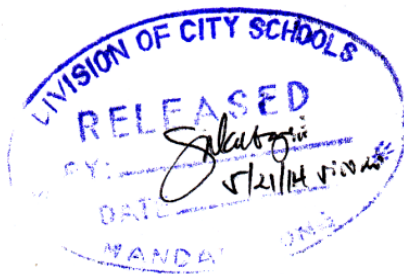

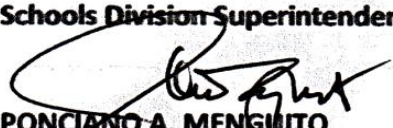

SUBJECT: REITERATION OF DEPED ORDER NO. 8 s. 2007

DATE : September 09, 2013

1. As stated in the Revised Implementing Guidelines on the Operation and Management of School Canteens in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools (DepEd Order no. 8, 2007), this Office would like to reiterate the following:
  - a. That school canteens should serve **ONLY** cooked nutritious foods at reasonable price (section No. 4.5). Attached to this memo is the list of suggested and non-suggested foods to be served in the school canteen as recommended by the Health and Nutrition Unit of the Region.
  - b. Teacher-advisers are prohibited to sell food stuffs inside the classrooms, especially junk foods, fortified or otherwise.
  - c. Supervised recess is not encouraged for this might cause discrimination to pupils who cannot afford to buy. It is recommended that a staggered schedule be adapted by schools to accommodate all learners to take their snacks/ meals in the canteen without prejudice to their daily contact time for learning.
2. Canteen personnel and canteen managers shall adhere strictly to the provisions stated in section 5.10 to 6.8 of the DepEd Order No. 8 such that henceforth, the canteen financial report shall be posted in the transparency board and that submission of the same shall be on semestral basis, copy furnished the Health and Nutrition Unit, the Region.
3. The submission of financial report shall become a basis for issuance of clearance to concerned personnel at the end of school year.
