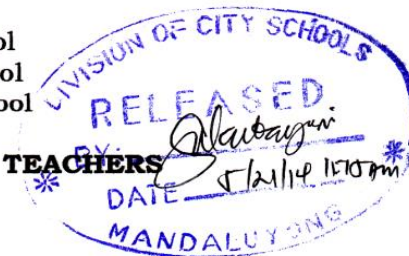

3. Immediate dissemination of this **Memorandum** is desired.

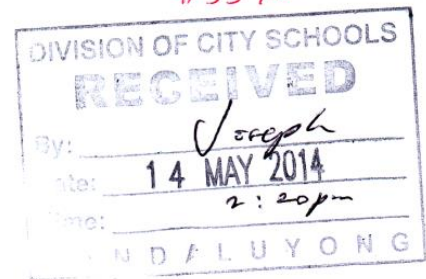
