Target: (indicate targeted grade level and explain briefly why?)

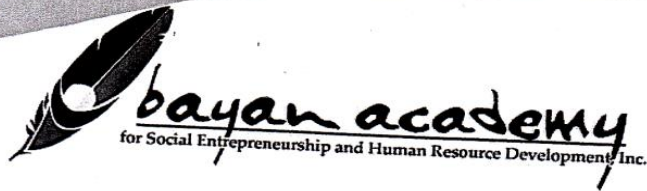
Proposed Plan of Action/Project/Program:

Dear **Dr. Almeda**:

As part of our continuing effort to develop the competencies of TLE teachers under the K to 12 Basic Educational Program, we would like to propose the following joint activities:

1. Recital per participant to determine their ability to demonstrate the needed competencies in teaching technopreneurship. Mechanics are as follows:
 - a. They would choose any topic discussed during the Teachers' Training on Technopreneurship (TTE).
 - b. They will be given at most 10 minutes to discuss the topic using the materials provided during the TTE.
 - c. Faculty from Bayan Academy shall serve as panelists to give their comments and inputs on the recitals.
 - d. The teachers might have to undergo another recital if they fail to pass the requirements.

Proposed dates:

May 26 - Batch 1

May 27 - Batch 2

May 28 - Batch 3

*recitals held due to unavailability of
conference room*

Once they pass, the teachers will be awarded a Trainer's Training Certificate. They could then be tapped to train other TLE teachers nationwide when the Teachers' Training on Entrepreneurship would be rolled out to the different regions.

2. Development of case studies on entrepreneurship based on the topics that were discussed in the TTE

The objective of this activity is to develop more learning materials on technopreneurship. Through this activity, the teachers will be able to immerse themselves and interact with actual entrepreneurs and learn from their stories.

The materials will be reviewed by Bayan Academy and, once accepted, could be shared among schools as additional learning material in teaching the Tech-Voc-Livelihood track of the K to 12. We shall also be exploring means on how these works could be published.




We would also like to partner with DepEd in developing the needed instructor's manual for the learning materials (videos, workbooks and technopreneurship modules) shared to the participants during the TTE. The output is a curriculum for the Grades 11-12 TLE. A writeshop could be held for the chosen technical working group for this endeavor. Two writers from the pool of participants will be selected per qualification to develop the manual and integrate these in the curriculum.

Bayan, as a TESDA-accredited provider, would also like to work with DepEd and TESDA on the issuance of NC II certificates and AM/TM assessment for teachers under the following qualifications:

1. Cookery NC II
2. Hairdressing NC II
3. Beauty Care NC II
