- d. Create opportunities for partnerships, engaging different stakeholders and interesting them in public education and your school community.

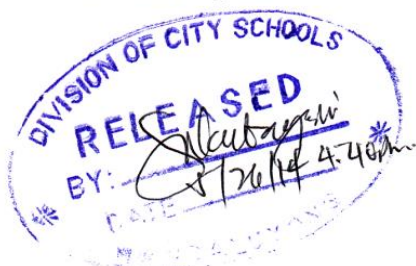
