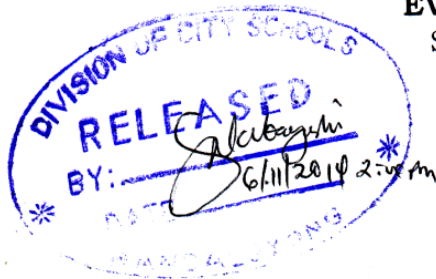

Dear Dr. Ladines,

"Catechesis is nothing other the process of transmitting the Gospel, as the Christian community has received it, understands it, celebrates it, lives it and communicates it in many ways." (GDC #105)

In compliance with the 1987 Constitutions of the Republic of the Philippines, Article XIV Education, Science and Technology, Arts, Culture and Sports, Sec.3

"At the option expressed in writing by the parents or guardians, religion shall be allowed to be taught to their children or wards in public elementary and high schools within the regular class hours by instructors designated or approved religious authorities of the religion to which the children or wards belong, without additional cost to the government."

And based on the Department of Education Order No. 49, s. 2009 , Enjoining Compliance to DECS Order no. 120, s. 1999 (Amending Certain Provisions of DECS Order no. 13, s. 1998)

Declaration of Policy – *The State shall, in conformity with the mandate of the Constitutions, encourage and promote the teaching of religion to children in public elementary and high schools within regular class hours. The State is cognizant of the vital role that teaching religion assumes in citizen formation, particularly the molding of our youth. Hence, the State recognizes the necessity of religious instruction not only in the private schools but also in the public schools. For these purpose, the Department hereby provides the mechanics to enable the teaching of*

religion in all public elementary and high schools in the country fully aware that the Constitution prohibits the government from favoring a particular establishment or religion or prohibiting the free exercise thereof. Furthermore, the implementation of this order should not entail cost to the government.

Coverage – This order shall apply to all public elementary and high schools in the Philippines.

*With this, I would like to endorse the **Catechists of the Archdiocese of Manila** in your school to carry out this mandate of the government and of the Catholic Church, Catechesis in Faith Development for Children and Youth, and to get class schedules for this SY 2014-2015.*

As Religion Teachers, they are bound to obey the Rules and Regulations of the School while being faithful to the Norms and Policies of the Archdiocesan Catechetical Ministry.

Their specific functions and responsibilities are as follows:

1. Classroom Catechesis (Elementary and High School)
2. Preparation of Lesson Plan
3. School Liturgy Preparation and Celebration
 - a. School Masses
 - b. Confessions
 - c. Recollections
 - d. Formation

I am truly grateful to you for accommodating our Catechists every year. You are indeed partners in this great mission of “Making Him known so that He may be loved.” Herewith is the list of names assigned in your school.
