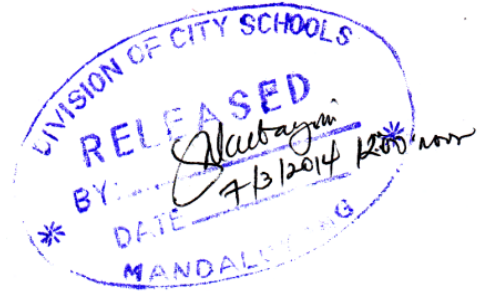

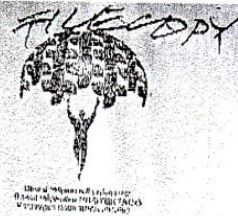

Greetings from Philippine Health Insurance Corporation!

In support to the Aquino Health Agenda (also known as Kalusugan Pangkalahatan) to provide universal health care for all Filipinos and in line with the implementation of the Joint Circular No. 001 s. 2014, Implementing Guidelines of PC No. 10, s. 2013 Expansion of Tamang Serbisyo Kalusugang Pampamilya (TSeKaP), formerly known as Primary Care Benefit 1 (PCB1) Package, to cover Personnel of the Department of Education (DepEd).
