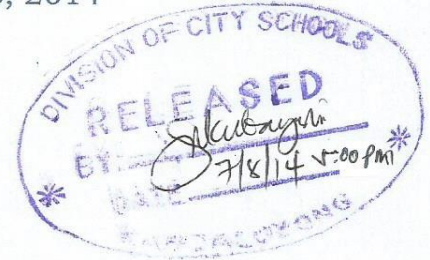

SUBJECT : 2014 BSP NATIONAL RAFFLE

1. The Executive Committee and confirmed by the National Executive Board in its meeting held 22 March 2014 approved the holding of the 2014 National Raffle. Drawing of winning numbers will be held on 12 December 2014 at the BSP National Office, Manila.
2. Hereunder are the features of this year's raffle:
 - a. Each ticket has its exclusive number and holds the chance of winning the whole cash gift. Each ticket will cost P20.00, and each booklet contains ten (10) tickets for a total of P200.00 per booklet.
 - b. Each ticket has a stub where the names of the donor and solicitor shall be legibly written for proper identification.
 - c. Ping-Pong balls will be used in drawing the winning numbers. Three (3) major gifts and twenty seven (27) consolation gifts will be given away, as follows:
 - I. Major Gifts (3)

1 st	-	Php 1,000,000.00
2 nd	-	Php 500,000.00
3 rd	-	Php 250,000.00
 - II. Consolation Gifts (27)

Two (2)	-	Php 100,000.00 each
Three (3)	-	Php 50,000.00 each
Five (5)	-	Php 20,000.00 each
Seven (7)	-	Php 10,000.00 each
Ten (10)	-	Php 5,000.00 each

The solicitor of each lucky winning ticket will be entitled to a modest gift of ten percent (10%) of the corresponding gift.

3. Proceeds will be distributed and shared as follows:


- I. Local Council Share - 70%
 -) 20% Seller's share
 -) 40% Local Council for Operations & Admin
 -) 10% Incentive for the Region & Local Council Staff

Note: Local Council will apportioned the 10% Incentive as follows:

- (1) 7% to Local Council Executive and Staff
- (2) 3% to Region Director and Staff.

II. National Office Share - 30% - to be remitted directly to National Office

- 4. For the allocation of 2014 raffle tickets, please accomplish the attached confirmation slip and return the same to National Office c/o Ms. Joanna B. Valeza, Ways and Means Executive, Economic Enterprise Division on or before 16 May 2014.
- 5. All local councils are hereby enjoined to participate in this undertaking.
