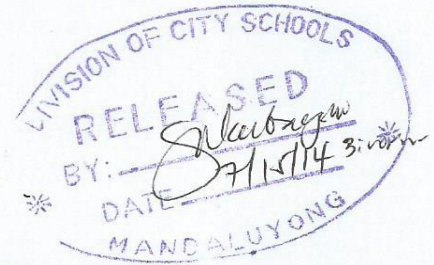

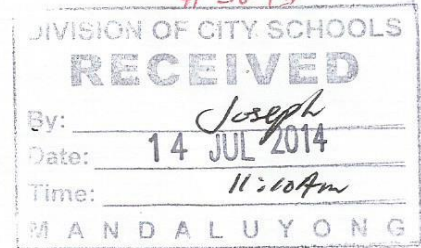

In strict adherence to the **Motorcycle Helmet Act of 2009** also known as **Republic Act 10054**, all city government employees including law enforcement agencies and peace keeping officers based in the City of Mandaluyong, who are motorcycle riders for official or unofficial functions or duties including their backriders as allowed by existing regulations as of this writing, **are directed to wear standard protective motorcycle helmets while driving, whether long or short drives, in any type of road and highway.**

It is reiterated that No government employees, including law enforcement bodies, peace keeping officers and the implementing local authorities themselves authorized by the City Government, shall be spared or excused from this directive. It is further emphasized that apart from the punishment/s mandated by existing regulations in Republic Act 10054 to all violators, administrative sanctions will also be applied.
