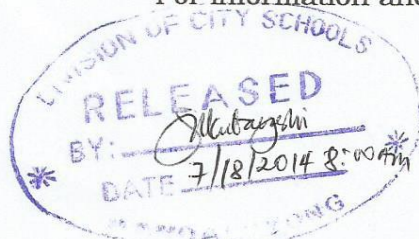

In view of the Training of Selected Grade 7 English, Science and Mathematics Teachers by the Philippine Science High School System (PSHSS) on May 7-11 & May 14-18, 2012, the field is hereby informed that this Office will grant service credits for the attendance and/or participation of the teachers in the above-stated training. Although the training is fully funded by the government, the decision to grant the service credits is pursued considering that the training is held during summer vacation where teachers are supposed to spend their time with their families and loved ones. Only the attendance on the Phase 1 which is on May 7-11 & May 14-18, 2012 will be granted service credits because the Phase 2 of the said training scheduled on October 24-28, 2012 is covered by the Mid-Year Assessment and INSET of Teachers.

Please be informed that one (1) work day vacation service credits shall be granted for six (6) hours of actual training. Likewise, this Office will strictly adhere to the maximum of fifteen (15) days service grants in a year as per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.

In line with this, school heads are requested to submit their teacher-participants' DTR, Individual Certificate of Appearance and Participation, a certification that their teachers did not avail the free board and lodging of the said training and a written request for the grant of service credits of their teachers. Please submit the documents for the grant of service credits on or before **July 23, 2014**. Only Ms. Eden Gripo, Mr. Johnlord Mendoza and Ms. Evangeline Jeciel of City Mandaluyong of Science High School have already complied in the above-stated documents submission.

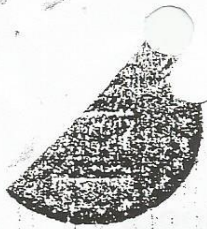

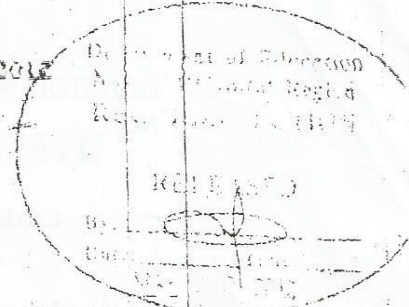

**TRAINING OF SELECTED GRADE 7 ENGLISH, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS
TEACHERS BY THE PHILIPPINE SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL SYSTEM (PSHSS)**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) in partnership with the Philippine Science High School System (PSHSS) and the Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) will train 1,530 Grade 7 teachers of English, Science and Mathematics (ESM) from the science high schools nationwide for the implementation of the Grade 7 of the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) starting School Year (SY) 2012-2013. The training is under the Upgrading Program: Learning Institute for Teachers (UPLIFT), which is the Project of PSHSS. The Training will be conducted in two (2) phases on the following dates:

Phase	Date	Venue
1 st Phase	May 7-11 and May 14-18, 2012	PSHSS campuses
2 nd Phase	October 24-28, 2012	

2. The details on the number of teachers per subject area, per campus are contained in the enclosure.

3. The teachers shall be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

- must be a teacher of science high school;
- preferably new in science, i.e. 1-5 years of teaching experience; in the event that there are no new teachers, those who need improvement will be preferred; and
- preferably coming from municipality/division with no or less SEI scholarship qualifiers.

4. A consolidated list of teachers by subject area and by school shall be submitted by the regional director (RD) to the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Programs and Projects (Attention: **Dr. Ruth Fuentes**) not later than **April 20, 2012**.

5. The RD shall see to it that the divisions/schools involved in the training under this Project shall cooperate and collaborate with the PSHSS on all processes, which include but not limited to the conduct of the training and the monitoring and evaluation of the impact of the training, and comply with the requirements pertinent to the completion of the project. For this purpose, a regional coordinator shall be designated and his/her name shall be indicated as such in the list of teachers to be submitted.

6. Participants should complete the two (2) phases of the training. A certificate of completion indicating the level of participation in the training shall be awarded to each participant.

7. Travelling expenses of the participants to and from the venue shall be charged to the school/division local funds while board and lodging shall be provided by PSHSS and DepEd.

8. Participants are expected to be at the training venue on Day 0 (a day before the training day). The first meal will be dinner of the same day. The training will start at 8:30 a.m. on May 7, 2012.
