

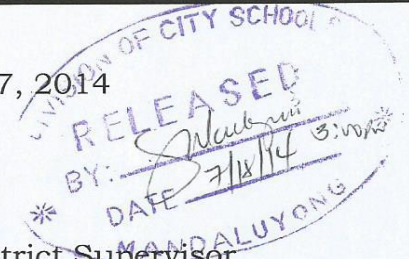

This office interposes **no objection** on the conditions that classes **will not be disrupted** and **parent's permit** shall be required for outside the school activities.

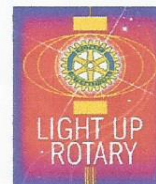
