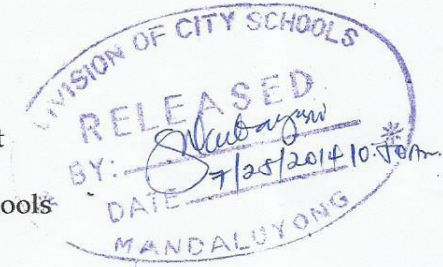

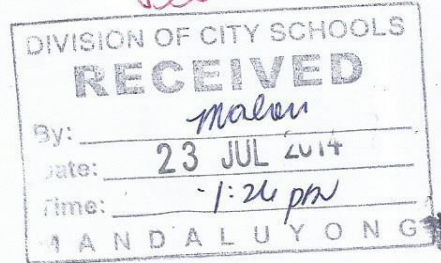

**MEMORANDUM ORDER**

NO: 04-06-2014

**SUBJECT: GUIDELINES FOR GRANTING GENERAL AMNESTY FOR  
 UNREGISTERED RADIO EQUIPMENT**

In the interest of service and pursuant to the National Telecommunications Commission's (NTC) thrust to abate the proliferation of unregistered radio equipment and in order to afford the owners/possessors/users thereof an opportunity to comply with existing rules and regulations, the Commission hereby amends Memorandum Order No. 02-01-2014 in the guidelines for the registration of undocumented radio equipment under the radio services mentioned hereof:

1. This Order shall apply only to:
  - a. Land Mobile Radio Service (Civic Action Groups / Government Agencies / Private Networks excluding Broadcast & Telecom)
  - b. Amateur Radio Service
2. The subsequent licensing of all radio equipment to be registered under and pursuant to this Order shall be in accordance with existing rules and regulations and the usual licensing procedures.
3. Registration Period  
 June 16 – July 23, 2014 - All NTC Regional Offices
4. Registration Fees



5. Holders of expired Amateur Radio Operator Certificate/Station License (ROC/RSL) and of Club Station Licenses that expired for more than five (5) years shall be allowed to renew their license without penalties and surcharges. However, an applicant shall pay arrears equivalent to license fee for every year or a fraction of a year that the license has expired. In line with the ongoing call sign management modernization program of the Commission, all amateur applications under this Order shall be issued a new call sign subject to its availability and on a first come first serve basis.

6. Operation of amateur radio equipment shall be authorized only within the amateur radio frequency channel/bands, 144.00 MHz – 146.00 MHz (non-expandable). However, radio equipment with expanded frequency band may be registered and licensed for a maximum of three (3) years only but not beyond December 31, 2017. After this period, no amateur radio operator certificate/station license shall be renewed without this radio equipment having been replaced and fixed to a non-expandable radio equipment.
7. Expired Radio Station License for more than five (5) years issued to Civic Action Groups/Government Agencies shall be allowed to renew without penalties and surcharges. However, an applicant shall pay arrears equivalent to license fee for every year or a fraction of a year that the license has expired.
8. Radio Equipment which are not type-approved/accepted for commercial band and are being used in Civic Action Groups and Government Stations, are hereby allowed to be registered and be issued a Radio Station License for a maximum validity period of three (3) years only but not beyond December 31, 2017. After this period, no radio station license shall be renewed without this radio equipment having been replaced to a commercially type-acceptance/approved unit.
9. Registrants and/or applicants shall only be accepted in NTC Regional Offices or during their Mobile Licensing Activities.
10. The registration of the above-stated radio equipment shall not be construed as an authority to construct and/or operate the same without the corresponding permits/licenses. Any violation pertaining to the use of such registered equipment including its use by persons other than the registrant shall be ground for appropriate administrative sanctions and/or fines and penalties as may be imposed by this Commission.
11. All the radio equipment registered under this Memorandum Order shall be at the accountability of the registrant.
12. All licenses which have been revoked by the final decision of the Commission are excluded from the amnesty program.
13. The Commission reserves the right to reject the registration of any radio equipment if and when warranted under the circumstances in the interest of the public.
14. This order supersedes other Memoranda and Orders inconsistent herewith.
