3. Enhance Math knowledge and skills of the participants.







The Annual GIRIS Interscholastic Math Competition
(Sponsored by the LSGH Mathematics Department and the Society of Math Students)

Rules and Regulations

- A. Eligibility of Contests
1. Each school must have three (3) female contestants, one for each of the following categories:
 - a. Algebra
 - b. Geometry
 - c. Trigonometry
 2. Each school may have one (1) alternate.
 3. Contestants may come from any year level.
- B. Nature of Competition
The competition shall be composed of two parts:
1. Individual
 2. Team Competition
- C. The Individual Competition
1. The three (3) representatives of each participating school shall take a written test in their respective categories.
 2. The top three contestants in each category shall be given gold, silver, and bronze medals respectively during the awarding ceremonies. Hence, all teams are requested to stay until the end of the awarding ceremonies.
- D. The Team Competition
1. The score of all the representatives of each school will be added and the total score will be used to determine those who will qualify for the team competition.
 2. The questions will include General Math (with Statistics), Algebra, Geometry, and Trigonometry.
 3. The eight (8) teams with the highest accumulated scores shall participate in the team competition.
 4. The top three (3) teams shall be awarded trophies.
- E. Deadline for confirmation is on January 12, 2015.
- F. Other rules and regulations shall be given at the time of competition.
