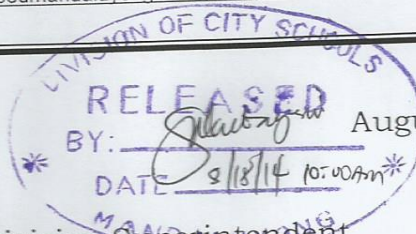



Through interagency collaboration and cooperation, the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) initiates the yearly observance of the National Crime Prevention Week (NCPW) every first week of September to effectively promote multisectoral participation in various crime prevention programs and activities of the government as well as create wider partnership with the community.

### NATIONAL CRIME PREVENTION WEEK OBSERVANCE

Good morning teachers and students. I am \_\_\_\_\_ (rank and name of police officer) \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ (police station) \_\_\_\_\_. I am here this morning to give you information on the weeklong observance of NATIONAL CRIME PREVENTION WEEK (NCPW).

Yearly since 1994, the whole Philippines observes NCPW on the first seven days of September (September 1 to 7). This is the 20<sup>th</sup> year, and the theme for 2014 is "*Krimen ay Labanan, Karapatan ay Igalang Tungo sa Mapayapang Pamayanan.*"

The celebration is under the auspices of the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM), and the Philippine National Police (PNP) through the help of an inter-agency and inter-disciplinary Technical Working Committee.

The observance is aimed at generating community awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of crime prevention and fostering interest and participation of the general public, especially students, in the prevention of crime and maintaining peace and order and public safety.

Although all sectors of society are enjoined to take part in the celebration, the heightened attention and active participation of students has been emphasized because of young people's vulnerability to fall as victims of crime and because of the increase in violent school-related incidents.

Crime, violence and disorder in schools have become major national issues. According to police records, students are vulnerable to robbery hold-ups, cellphone snatching, and drug abuse. In recent years, we have several reports of fatal fraternity hazing incidents, sexual assaults and harassment in campuses, bullying, gambling and gang or fraternity wars. These problems not only endanger students and teachers, but they also prevent

from concentrating on teaching and students from  
concentrating on learning.

This changing educational climate has created an imperative need for schools to identify tools, strategies, and model programs that enhance the safety and success of all children and school employees and authorities. Because young people are legally required to attend school, school personnel have a corresponding duty to provide children with a safe, secure and peaceful environment in which learning can occur. Achieving this end requires that every school district and each individual school develop a school safety plan.

One program we are suggesting that your school adopts is the organization of the Student Crime Prevention Committee (SCPC). The SCPC benefits the school, the students and your barangay. Benefits may be immediate, such as making the school safer, as well as long-term, such as making crime prevention a behavioral norm. The concept is simple. It is anchored on the belief that if young people are given the opportunity to take the lead in making their schools safer, such would benefit both the schools and themselves and their respective communities. Student involvement in the network will strengthen the social bonds that are essential to their healthy growth as members of a larger community and make them increase their sense of social responsibility.

There are a number of activities where students may involve themselves such as assisting school security officers to patrol hallways, corridors and catwalks; organize forums to give students a chance to air concerns about safety; establishing school-based incident reporting system, airing of crime prevention announcements over the public address system every morning; and developing other crime prevention awareness activities. We, your local police and NAPOLCOM will help you organize your SCPC.

We assure you that your police is here to help you in all your safety needs and is always ready to render service and assistance whenever needed. During emergencies like fire, flood, calamities or when witnessing a crime, you may call your police through \_\_\_\_\_ (police number/hotline).
