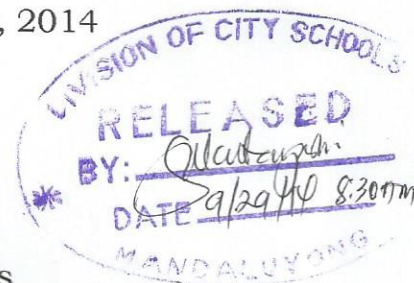



A. AGRO-INDUSTRIAL FAIR GUIDELINES

- I. Schedule/ venue : October 1-3, 2014, DepEd-NCR Ground
- II. Participants : 16 School Divisions
- III. General Guidelines :

1. The Division Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhasan (EPP) Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and Alternative Learning System (ALS) Supervisors are requested to be the focal persons of the activity.
2. All Division participants in the Agro-Industrial Fair will be given a Certificate of Participation before the end of the day's activity through the Division Supervisors.
3. The activities wherein each school divisions should prepare are as follows:
 - a. Installation of booth - The size of the booth shall be 5x5 meters and it shall be divided into three parts, one part for the Agro-Industrial, one part for the Instructional and one part for DRRM. The assignment of the booth by the participating school divisions shall be in draw lot on October 1, 2014 except for Makati City.
 - b. The Agro-Industrial components are as follows:
 - Vertical Gardening
 - Hydroponics
 - Acquaculture
 - EPP/ TLE/ H.E. Projects
 - c. The Vertical Garden shall be made of recycled materials. The size of the vertical garden shall be 2x2 meters.
 - d. The Hydroponic Garden shall be made of recycled materials. The number of styro box shall not exceed 5 boxes.
 - e. The Acquaphonics shall be made of recycled materials. The size/ length will depend on the design provided and it will not cover one part of the booth.
 - f. The EPP/ TLE/ H.E shall be made of recycled materials except for the H.E food items.
4. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Creativity	20 points
b. Arrangement and Presentation	10 points
c. Quality/ durability of the products	30 points
d. Quality/ growth of the plants	30 points
e. Cleanliness and orderliness	<u>10 points</u>
Total:	100% points

5. The final judging will be on October 3, 2014.
6. The installation of the booth will start on October 1, 2014.
