

Greetings!

We are ATRIEV, a not-for profit organization that provides computer training and services for the blind. We teach blind people how to use computers through a software that translates every keystroke and mouse click into speech output. To date, we have trained over 300 blind and visually impaired students in the use of MS Office applications, some of whom have become call center agents, content writers, programmers and even one SEO manager.

This October 27, ATRIEV will mark its 20th year anniversary as a champion of the visually-impaired and a staunch advocate of vocational rehabilitation and empowerment of persons with disabilities in the country.

In celebration of this momentous occasion, October 2-3, 2014, we are holding a Digital Innovations Workshop as part of the Special Education Track of the Digital Strategies for Development Summit (DS2) for Special Education teachers and program implementers to be held in the Asian Institute of Management in Makati City, Philippines. This workshop-forum aims to discuss the latest trends in special and inclusive education to include innovations in teaching children and young people with visual, orthopedic and hearing impairments.
