Immediate dissemination of this **Memorandum** is desired.

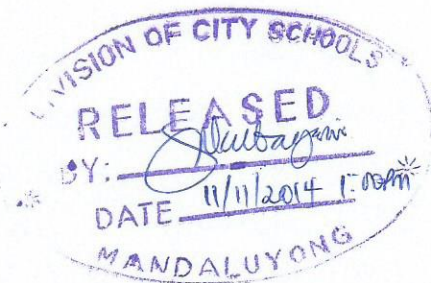



FAPSA 17th GENERAL ASSEMBLY



The **Federation of Associations of Private School & Administrators (FAPSA)** signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Taiwan's Institute for Information Industry (III) spearheaded by the Board of Investment of the DTI during the five-day visit of Fapsa Officers to Taiwan this October.

The MOU gives way to cooperation in Smart Education as well as arranging K to 12 school visits to Taiwan of Fapsa member schools for ICT technologies and E-Learning pedagogy. The Taiwanese belong to the top 10 in the global education and supply 90% of the world gadgets.

The best practice in E-Learning Education shall be spelled out in **FAPSA 17th GENERAL ASSEMBLY** for implementation of interested administrators next year including the **PLDT partnership proposal with Fapsa** which shall benefit our schools, teachers and students with low-cost hardware even the solutions to poor Wi-Fi.

This Fapsa G.A. will be held on **November 30, 2014, Sunday, (7am -5pm)** at the **SM Aura SMX, Taguig City.**

The Assembly, therefore, aims to thresh out the following agenda:

1. Presenting Taiwan's E-Learning success by the **Taiwan pioneers** themselves for the private schools' possible implementation next year
2. Hearing from PLDT about fast Wi-Fi, cheap laptops, bandwidth, servers, fiber optics and other packages exclusive for Fapsa member-schools
3. Getting update from the solon who filed **House Bill 4813** seeking to create a Bureau of Private Schools to address the problems of private institutions in the country.
4. Getting the latest development on Senior High School of K to 12 program
5. Absorbing tips on how to raise funds for all school needs.
6. Recognizing The Outstanding Partners of Private Schools (**TOPPS**) and, Giving a little time to organize interested schools to visit Taipei

The **fee is P1000 pesos/pax to cover am/pm snacks including lunch** and some seminar materials. We encourage on-site payment of registration fee.

This is not only a means by which to move on, but for some, it means survival in a competitive environment. This advocacy shall empower schools addressing in broad strokes problems in financial operation.
