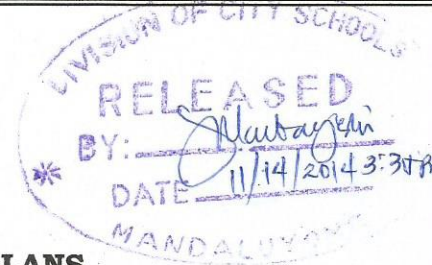


**MEMORANDUM**
