**A. BEST DIVISION OL TRAP IMPLEMENTER AWARD CRITERIA**

Performances of the 16 city divisions shall be evaluated by DOST-NCR based on the following criteria:

- At least 90% of the total data from the school had been transmitted and reflected in the dengue website ([www.dengue.ph](http://www.dengue.ph));
- Complete hardcopies of the data had been submitted to DOST-NCR, the City Health Office, and DepEd Division Office (for validation purposes);
- There is at least 85% rating for on-site school validation by the Regional Coordinator;
- Impact of the OL Trap project to the school (ie. Reduction of reported dengue cases, reduced mosquito population density)
- Linkages initiated with local community / individuals;
- Introduced new or improved systems / procedure that made the program more efficient / effective;
- Heightened awareness among school heads, teachers, and students regarding the OL Trap System (via random sample interview)

**B. BEST SCHOOL OL TRAP IMPLEMENTER AWARD MECHANICS**

1. DepEd Division Offices shall nominate three (3) schools per division / city that are included on the NDVS Program.
2. All nominees must be submitted by **November 17, 2014**.
3. The evaluating team shall be composed of one (1) representative from the Center for Health Development (CHD-NCR), one (1) representative from Department of Education (DepEd-NCR), and one (1) from the Philippine Council for Health Research and Development (DOST-PCHRD). All schools shall be visited by the evaluating team.
4. Criteria for judging:  
The finalist will be selected based on the above criteria.

**C. ON-THE-SPOT POSTER AND SLOGAN MAKING CONTEST MECHANICS AND CRITERIA**

**Mechanics**

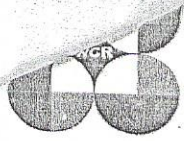
1. The contest will be open to all schools participating in the Nationwide Dengue Vector Surveillance Program in NCR. We will only accept **first 30 contestants for primary level and first 30 contestants for the secondary level**. Deadline for names of participating contestants will be on **November 17, 2014**.
2. **Registration** for contest participants is from **7:30-8:00 AM on December 10, 2014**. Only registered participants will be able to join the contest. We shall follow the Juan time, Filipino time.

3. A 10-minute break shall be provided to the examinees after the contest briefing or before the contest proper. Once the contest proper starts, no participant shall be allowed to enter or leave the premises for whichever reason or purpose. Only assigned marshals are allowed to enter therein.
4. The poster and slogan should be built on a theme related to the objectives of the program that shall be revealed before the contest proper starts.
5. Posters and slogans should be completed within three (3) hours in the designated venue together with the assigned marshals.
6. Each participant should bring their own drawing / painting / coloring materials for the contest.
7. Each participant shall be given one (1) illustration board. Assigned marshals shall have the authority to confiscate other media not otherwise indicated or allowed. Confiscated media shall be returned after the contest proper.
8. A slogan, which serves as the title of the artwork, must not exceed 12 words. The slogan, together with a one (1) - paragraph interpretation of the poster of at least 100 words, shall be written on a sheet of paper provided and shall be attached to the back of the artwork.
9. The use of mobile phones and/or other electronic devices shall be prohibited during the contest proper.
10. Criteria:
  - Relevance to the theme = 30%
  - Creativity = 20%
  - Interpretation = 20%
  - Originality = 20%
  - Correct Grammar = 10%
