### DEPED-NCR'S PARTICIPATION IN THE 6<sup>TH</sup> ASEAN SCHOOLS GAMES

To: Schools Division Superintendents  
School Heads, Public and Private Schools

1. The 6<sup>th</sup> ASEAN schools Games will be held in the Philippines on November 29 to December 7, 2014 with the Department of Education, the Host City, Marikina City and other Government Departments and Agencies at the helm of the preparation.
2. In support to the activity, the Department of Education-National Capital Region is tasked to assist in the preparation of the event. Hence, the different schools divisions are requested to be part of this international event.
3. Attached is the list of activities that will need the involvement of the Schools Division Superintendents, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Supervisors, Principals, Teachers and Students.
4. To ensure the success of this International Games, school officials, teachers, students and parents are encouraged to watch the games to boost the morale of the delegates as well as revitalize the love of sports among school communities.
5. It is requested that make-up classes and other academic projects and assignments be provided to the athletes and other participants to compensate for the lost hours incurred as a result of their participation in this activity.
6. Officiating Officials, Coaches and Teachers will be granted service credit for every day served on weekends and for the extra hours rendered on weekdays but not to exceed five (5) days during the conduct of the 6<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Schools Games. Likewise, all DepEd Officials, Region and Division PESS Supervisors and Staff can avail of the compensatory time-off, not to exceed five (5) days during the conduct of the 6<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Schools Games. The guidelines on the grant of service and compensatory time-off (per DepEd Order No. 52, s. 2003) should be observed.
7. All expenses relative to the conduct of the 6<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Schools Games maybe charged against the MOOE /Local Funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
