REGIONAL MEMORADUM No. 280, s. 2012**

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 5546 and pertinent DepEd Orders, and due to numerous complaints, this Office issued **Regional Memorandum No. 280, s. 2012 prohibiting schools from initiating, conducting or allowing distribution to and sale of tickets to pupils/students for film showing, stage plays and other shows**, among others.
2. Notwithstanding the said Memorandum, and the cases filed against erring school personnel/officials, complaints on this kind of activity against schools, school heads, and teachers are incessant
3. Accordingly, the field is hereby warned that violation of the said Memorandum and accompanying guidelines by any school official, teacher or personnel, shall cause the filing of administrative charges by this Office.
4. Schools Division Superintendents and Principals shall ensure receipt of this Memorandum by the teachers. The proof of receipt shall be kept in the custody of the Principals and the Division Superintendents. This Office shall require submission thereof when the need arises.

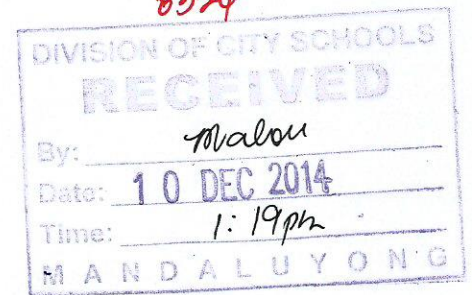

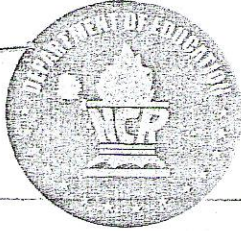


**REITERATION ON A PROHIBITED ACTIVITY UNDER

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES/PROGRAMS

1. This Office has been receiving complaints relative to various school initiated activities, projects and other requirements which demand contribution or payment from pupils/students. These increase the cost of education which are added burden on the part of the parents in public schools.

2. Public Schools are enjoined to focus on basic academic programs and mandated extra-curricular activities in line with the Calendar of Activities of the Department. Other activities/programs outside the authorized regular school activities where school children are being required to participate shall not be implemented without the approval of the Schools Division Superintendent.

3. Schools are discouraged from undertaking or attending to activities which are not directly geared towards the improvement of learners performance and quality education. Accordingly, effective immediately, all public schools are hereby prohibited to initiate, conduct or allow the following activities:

- a. Distribution to and sale of tickets to pupils/students for film showing, stage play and other shows
- b. Costly trips
- c. Promoting the purchase of books and other learning materials or school supplies

4. Lamination of ID or ID jacket shall be left to the responsibility of the parents. Schools shall not collect for ID lamination/jacket.

3. Violation of this Memorandum shall be dealt with administratively by this Office.
4. School Heads and Schools Division Superintendents shall be accountable on any activity at the schools in violation hereof.
5. Division Offices shall submit to the Regional Office the proof of receipt of this Memorandum by the School Heads.
