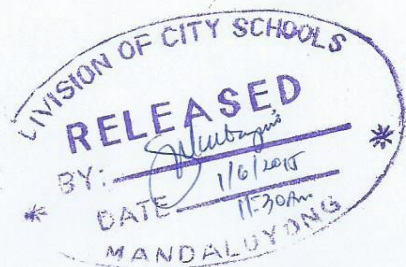
**ANTI-BULLYING POLICY AND/OR CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

Attached is the summary of the status of compliance to the memorandum for submission of report, re: adoption and submission of Anti-Bullying Policies or Child Protection Policies with Anti-Bullying Policy by all schools, both public and private.

This is the subject of the Memorandum issued by this Office on September 2, 2014 and the earlier Regional Memorandum No. 124, s. 2014.

Pursuant to Section 14.2. of the IRR of the Anti-Bullying Act, private schools that fail to comply shall be given notice of such failure by the Division Office. Non-compliance is a ground for suspension or even revocation of the school's permit/recognition. For public schools, it is a ground for administrative disciplinary proceedings. The policies need not be submitted to this Office except in the application for permit of private schools. As stated in the Regional Memorandum No. 124, s. 2014, the Division Office shall be the repository of the said Policies.

Accordingly, Schools Division Superintendents shall enjoin compliance of all schools. A complete report shall be submitted on or before December 10, 2014 by all Divisions following the form attached.

The policies should be in accordance with the Rules Implementing the Anti-Bullying Act promulgated by the Department on December 13, 2013 and the DepEd Child Protection Policy.
