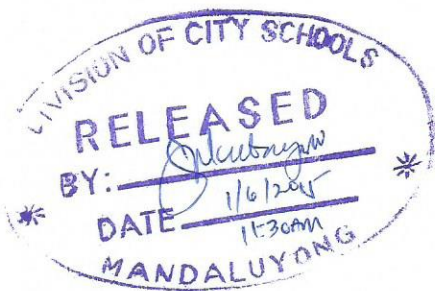

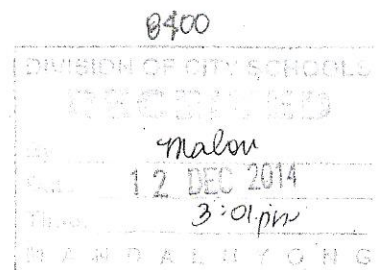

It is for this reason that we are humbly asking for your permission to allow our Grade VI Pupils to revisit and interact with the students in the schools enumerated below:

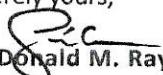

We are hoping for your positive response. May God bless you and your loved ones generously!

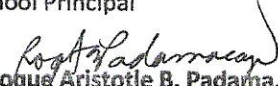
