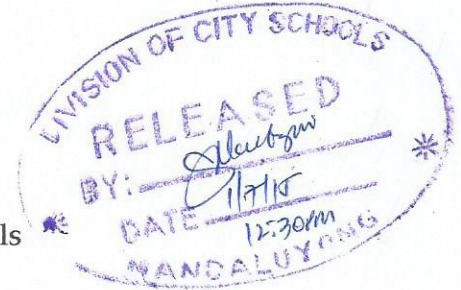

Dear Dr. Almeda:

On October 2009, the Diliman Computer Technology Institute partnered with Unitech Educational Program Corporation to offer a unique program that gives underprivileged public students from as early as grade 6 to 4th year high school access to a customized Computer Literacy Training Program for 14 weeks at 1 2-hour session per week. The Computer Literacy Training Program consists of 7 modules combining both office applications and graphics proficiency. To date, 7,000 students have benefited from the program and are now enjoying the advances gained in their trainings.

On January 2012 however, mounting complaints and contract violations called our attention prompting us to conduct investigations and verifications to the alleged abuses and misrepresentations of Unitech Educational Program Corporation that were eventually proven to be true. Therefore, Diliman Educational Corporation cancelled our Partnership Agreement effective June 2012.

We would like to reiterate that we are no longer connected in any way to Unitech Educational Program Corporation. We would also like to ask your office to help us inform all Dep Ed Superintendents of NCR that Unitech's misrepresentation. Further, we would like to caution your office of Unitech's illegal activities such as misrepresenting private institutions and scholarship foundations, and more importantly forcing students to pay scholarship examination fees.

We would be more than willing to help your office in any way to help investigate abuses made by Unitech Educational Program Corporation.
