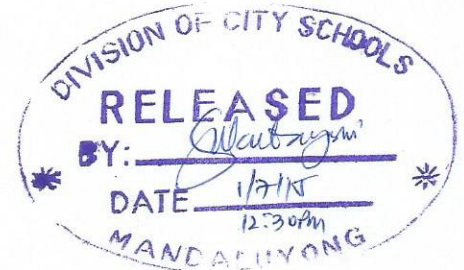

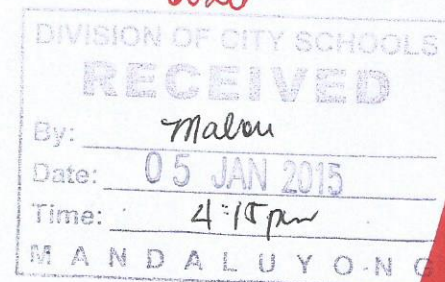

GUIDELINES

I. GENERAL

1. Participating school may decide to join all or any of the following contests:
 - a. **Poetry Reading** Feb. 3, 2015 8:00-12:00 nn.
 - b. **Extemporaneous Speech** Feb. 3, 2015 1:00- 5:00 pm.
 - c. **Science and Math Quiz Bee** Feb. 4, 2015 8:00-12:00 nn.
 - d. **Speech Choir** Feb. 4, 2015 1:00- 5:00 pm.
2. Contestant may compete in several of the contests mentioned.
3. Delegation of at least 10 students from the participating school will be given an additional 10 points to the total score except for the Speech Choir category.
4. Participating schools and contestants will receive certificate of participation and winners will receive cash incentives and trophies.

II. SPECIFIC

POETRY READING CONTEST

February 3, 2015

8:00 – 12:00nn

Main Auditorium

1. There will be one common piece open for interpretation.
2. Each contestant will be provided with the contest piece and will be given 5 minutes to prepare before the contest proper.
3. The contestants will be contained in a room during the presentation.
4. The contest piece will be retrieved from the contestant at the start of the competition.
5. Advisers or coaches will not be allowed in the holding area.
6. The contestants will be given a maximum of 5 minutes to deliver the poem in an open microphone.
7. School participation of at least 10 students (excluding the contestant and adviser will be given ten (10) points. This will be added to the total score obtained during the contest to determine the winners.
8. The decision of the board of judges is final.

Voice and Articulation -----	25 Points
Manner of Delivery -----	25 Points
School Participation -----	10 Points

EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEECH

February 3, 2015

1:00 – 5:00pm

Main Auditorium

1. The contest is limited to only one (1) contestant per school.
2. All contestants will be contained in one area.
3. The topic will be presented to each contestant 5 minutes before delivery.
4. Order of presentation will be determined by drawing of lots.
5. The contestants will be given five (5) minutes to deliver orally.
6. The contestant has to wait for one (1) bell signal to start his/her speech. A warning sign for the last one (1) minute will be shown to the contestant to recap his/her speech. Two (2) bells signal a stop to the speech.
7. School participation of at least 10 students (excluding the contestant and adviser) will be given ten (10) points. This will be added to the total score obtained during the contest to determine the winners.
8. The decision of the board of judges is final.

SCIENCE AND MATH QUIZ BEE

February 4, 2015

8:00 – 12:00nn

Main Auditorium

1. School participants (at least 10 non-contestants) and two (2) contestants (with valid I.D's) are required to be at the contest venue on time.
2. Advisers are requested to prepare the list of names of their school participants and submit it to the Registration Committee to speed up the registration.

3. The quizmaster will read every question twice while the question is simultaneously projected on screen. Answering of questions may start in the first reading but final answers must be written on the flashboard 10 SECONDS after the "GO" signal has been given at the end of the second reading.
4. Participants should stop writing and must raise up their flashboards once the signal to "STOP" is given. They should wait to be acknowledged before putting down their flashboards.
5. In case of a tie, the "SUDDEN DEATH SYSTEM" will be implemented where a tie-breaker question will be given successively until the tie is broken and a higher ranking is obtained.
6. Complaints or points of disagreement on answers to a given question must be raised immediately by the adviser to the board of judges before the next question is asked. All decisions of the board of judges are final.
7. Scores for school participation (10 points) will be added to the aggregate scores of the team contestants at the end of the last question to determine the winners.
