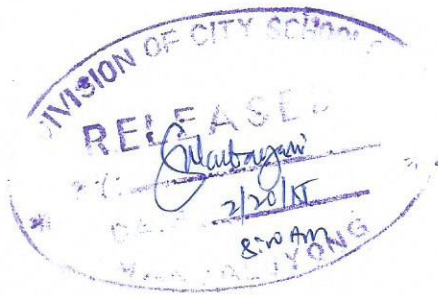



1. The Asia-Pacific Centre of Education for International Understanding (APCEIU) through the Department of Education-National Capital Region is inviting nominees to the **2015 Korea- Philippines Teacher Exchange Program**, for 18 elementary and two (2) secondary teachers to visit Korea for three (3) months from April to July 2015.

Qualifications:

- a. Elementary Teachers need not have specialization but capable of teaching any subject indicated in the subject preference list (English, Science, Mathematics, Sociology, History, Geography, P.E./Art/Music, Korean language and Ethics). However, secondary teachers must be a major in any of the subjects mentioned,
- b. At least three (3) years teaching experience (over 10 years teaching term left and has not been a recipient of any Korean program funding),
- c. Willing to undertake activities that enhance mutual understanding between Korea and the Philippines,
- d. Preferably a Master Teacher, and
- e. Exhibits positive attitude at all times.

2. Each Division is entitled to three (3) nominees two (2) elementary and one (1) secondary, who shall submit the following documents on or before February 25, 2015:
 - a. Official nomination signed by the Schools Division Superintendent
 - b. Curriculum Vitae with passport size picture
 - c. Certification signed by the Principal/School Head stating that if ever the teacher is chosen, his/her class shall be properly attended to
 - d. Certification of the teacher's performance for the last three (3) rating periods signed by the Principal/School Head, preferably VS (Very Satisfactory) performance
 - e. Valid passport, (at least one (1) year) photocopied, first 4 and the last 2 pages
 - f. Bank Certification of personal savings account.
3. Interview will be on March 4 – 5 at 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM or 3:00 – 5:00 PM, CLMD Office.
