As there are a number of registered test takers who were unable to take the last Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test, a Special A&E Test shall be conducted on February 27, 2015, (Friday) at the Bureau of Alternative Learning System DepEd Central Office.

The test is free, and shall be administered in the morning and afternoon. Interested parties must come at 7:00 A.M. (for the morning test) and at 12:30 p.m. (for the afternoon test) with the following requirements in original format:

- 2"x2" photo (scanned photos will not be accepted);
- Form 137;
- one (1) government-issued I.D.; and
- authenticated birth certificate for test takers 15 years old and below.

The A&E Special Test intends to provide access to the 2014 A&E Test services to all.

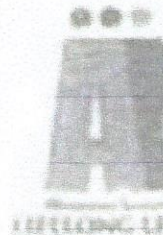


