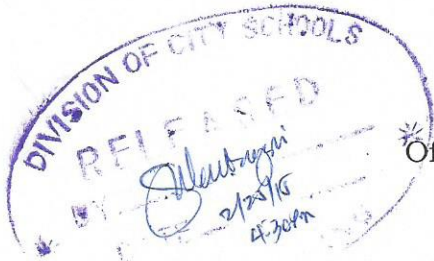

The essence of accessibility is convenience. If a building is accessible it does not automatically follow that it is convenient. Hence, for election purposes, the test of accessibility is necessarily a test of convenience.

The Dictionary defines convenience as a quality or situation that makes something easy or useful for someone by reducing the amount of work or time required to do something.

The phrase "easy or useful" should be the guiding post of all OEOs in determining if a voting center/polling place is accessible or not.

The herein required data shall be submitted to the Precincts and Voting Centers Division of EBAD within fifteen (15) days after the February 21, 2015 SK Elections.
