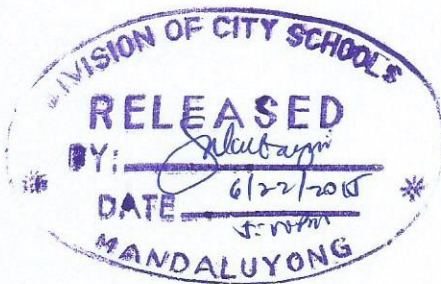



2015 Search of the Ten Outstanding Senior Scouts of the City of Mandaluyong Council

1. To give due recognition to our scouts, who best exemplify sterling qualities of Institution, community, leadership, academic excellence and good moral character who serve as a role model to their fellow youth.
2. The search is open to Senior Scouts who are Filipino Citizens, currently enrolled in private or public school schools, members of community scouting institution and currently registered within City of Mandaluyong Council, BSP.
3. Each Sponsoring Institution is entitled to submit only one nomination to the Selection Committee.
4. The Institutional Representative will accomplish the entry form in duplicate and send them to Mandaluyong Youth Development Center, 441 F. Ortigas St., Hagdan Bato Itas, City of Mandaluyong not later than June 30, 2015.
5. The preliminary selection of the finalist will be on July 7, 2015 at BSP, City of Mandaluyong Council. This will be conducted based on the documents submitted by the candidates.
6. The finalist will be notified by the selection through official communication.
7. Final interview on the finalist will be conducted at the Council Headquarters by the Board of Judges on July 18, 2015.
8. The criteria for the selection are as follows:
  - **Performance (40%)**- Scouts involvement in Scouting Activities, community, conferences, seminars or position held in school, church organization including scout advancement
  - **Award/Recognition (25%)**- refers to academic and non-academic awards, honors, recognition given to Scout. Example most outstanding Supreme Student Government President, outstanding citizens, essay, declamation.
  - **Character (15%)** -refers to the character and spiritual development of scout. There must be a certification from his religious leaders that he is faithful in the practice of his religious responsibilities.
  - **Interview (20%)**-the ability of Scout to express himself in a clear and understandable manner during the interview.
9. The entry form will be accomplished by the nominee and must be endorsed by his Outfit Advisor and the Institutional Head and certified by the Council Scout Executive.
10. The decision of the Selection Committee and the Board of Judges is final.
