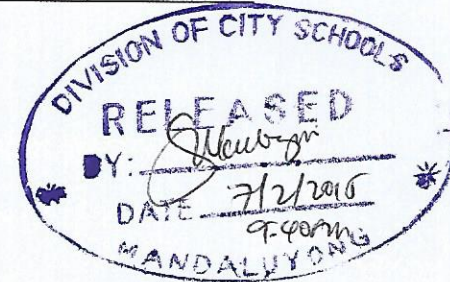

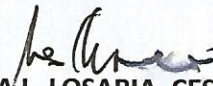

SUBJECT : Orientation of Schools along the East and West Valley Fault System
on Earthquake Preparedness

DATE : 30 June 2015

The Valley Fault System (VFS), traversing portions of the National Capital Region (NCR), Region III, and Region IV-A, poses threats of ground rupture and shaking, liquefaction, landslide, and tsunami that may lead to loss of lives and destruction of properties. As such, preparedness, especially among school personnel and learners, is an imperative.

In this regard, a series of orientation with all schools that could be affected by the VFS will be conducted on 6-10 July 2015 (**ANNEX 1: Indicative Program**) to:

- Orient school officials on the possible effects of earthquake and related risks;
- Present updates on DRRM systems, protocols and processes in DepEd from national to the school level; and
- Discuss the family earthquake preparedness homework.

This one-day activity will be conducted in eight batches with the following schedule:
