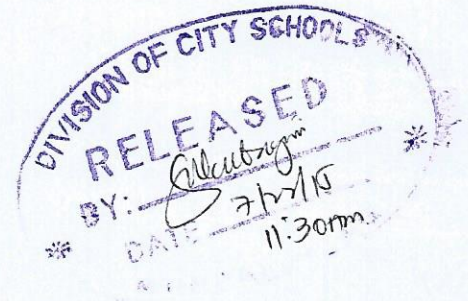



Greetings from WWF-Philippines!

**World Wide Fund for Nature - Philippines (WWF-Philippines)** is a non-stock, non-profit global conservation organization whose mission is to stop the degradation of our planet's natural environment, and build a future in which humans live in harmony with nature. WWF-Philippines works with the academe to achieve these goals through intensive information and education campaigns.

Since 2013, WWF-Philippines has been in partnership with the Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation (HSBC) in order to promote our joint advocacy on **water conservation and smart water practices** in schools and in communities through **The Rain Campaign Program**.
