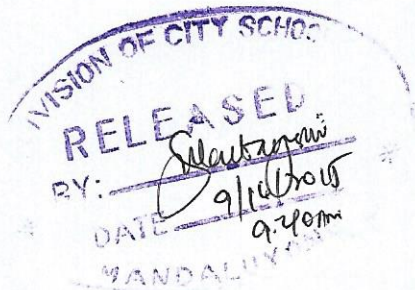

3. enhance their coaching abilities by being competent in Mathematics content, in order to increase students' Mathematics achievement in competitions.

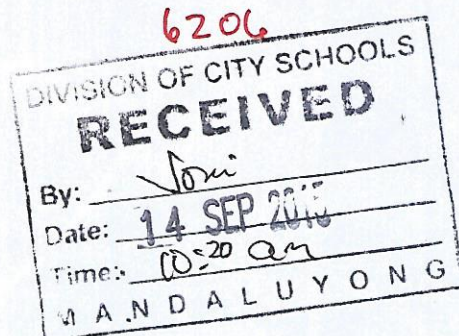
The target participants are Mathematics teachers, coordinators, head teachers and supervisors from both public and private schools.
