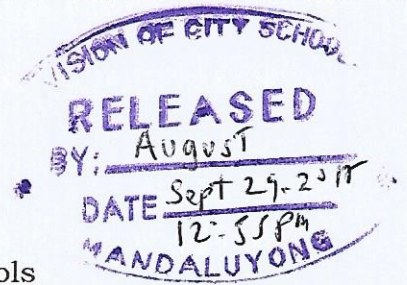


MEMORANDUM

Subject: **INTENSIVE TRAINING FOR MATHEMATICALLY TALENTED STUDENTS (ITMTS)**

Date: September 28, 2015



1. The SDO-Mandaluyong in collaboration with the Mathematics Trainers' Guild, Philippines (MTG), in its thrusts of developing and empowering human resources through training programs and the vision of making Filipino students become globally competitive particularly in international mathematics competition, the **Intensive Training for Mathematically Talented Students (ITMTS)** shall be conducted in this Division starting SY 2015-2016,

2. This training program has been developed to help teachers motivate, stimulate and develop mathematically gifted and talented Grades 3 to 10 pupils/students for both public and private schools.

Specifically, it aims to:

- a. foster interest in and awareness of the power of mathematics;
- b. provide stimulating mathematics problems;
- c. identify talented Filipino kids and provide support to enable them to reach their own level of excellence;
- d. prepare them to international math competitions;
- e. provide Filipino global competitiveness and national/international brotherhood.

3. The ITMTS will be conducted by the Mathematics Trainers' Guild (MTG), (a non-stock organization) in three phases; namely:

TRAINING PHASES	DATE	COST
A. Mathematical Challenge for Filipino Kids Training Program (MCFKTP) for 12 Saturdays	September, 2015 – February, 2016	P 4, 200
B. Young Mathematicians In-house Training Program (YMIITP) for One (1) week	April, 2016	P 7, 000
C. Mathematics Olympiad Summer Training Program (MOSTP) for One (1) month	May, 2016	P 8, 000

*** Qualifiers in the MOSTP are being trained for the International Mathematics Competition in various countries.

4. A qualifying exam shall be given to potential trainees for SDO-Mandaluyong on September 29, 2015 at **2nd Floor Conference of Highway Hills Integrated School**. The tests will start at **8:00 am**.

5. Participation of the identified schools is expected:

Elementary : Grades 1 to 6

DPCGES – 3 pupils per grade level (Total: 12 pupils)

ILIS – 1 pupil per grade level (Total:4 pupils)

Secondary : Grade 7 to 10


CMSHS & MPNAG – 5 students per grade level
(Total : 20 students / school)

HHIS – 1 student per grade level (Total : 4 students)

6. An amount of forty pesos (P40.00) shall be collected per student for the qualifying examination. Incurred expenses shall be charged to the school special fund for SSES & ESEP and school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

7. The start of the training will be on **October 3, 2015, 1:00 to 4:00 pm** at **Nemesio Yabut Elementary School, Makati City**.

8. Wide and immediate dissemination of this **Memorandum** is desired.
